Economic Development Report – Paul Kelly

Cochran ó kick off meeting with EDS in early Sept.

Had kick off meeting with Cochran and Baltimore street design meeting on or about sept. 6th to introduce everyone. Oct 3rd, 2018 was the second meeting between Design Committee and William Cochran. William presented ideas to the group to decide on. (colors of pavers, trees, water fountain, etc.) November 10th will be the public Reimagine Cumberland meeting held at the Allegany Arts Council.

Kathy ó Centre Street parklet ó spent 16,000 of 25,000. Benches will be coming in soon and plaques.
