Rivers and Rails Festival: The Rivers and Rails Festival will be the weekend of September 7th-9th. The DDC is supporting by bringing The Sheatles in to play on Friday night. The festival will be in support of the River Park Project. Dee Dee Ritchie from Canal Place gave a presentation explaining the project and how it would positively impact Canal Place. The proposed River Park will include a whitewater attraction for kayak and canoe travel, along with trail connections, a spectator area and scenic overlook. The Festival will kick off Friday with the Sheatles and a showing of Star Wars: The Last Jedi. Saturday there will be music, vendors, speakers and activities throughout the day. The festival is free and open to the public. Sunday will be a morning church service, followed by music until 2pm to wrap up the festivities.
