## RESOLUTION

**Resolution of the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland supporting the application for the Community Legacy Project (the "Project") further described in the Community Legacy Application ("The Application") submitted by the Cumberland Economic Development Corporation regarding the Baltimore Street Access Project, to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Allegany County; and,

WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the Project is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of the Community Legacy Project and the Project Financing by the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland, Maryland and, where appropriate, by the chief elected executive official of the local subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland hereby endorses the Community Legacy FY2019 Application submitted by the Cumberland Economic Development Corporation (the "CEDC") with regard to the Baltimore Street Access Project, hereby designating the aforementioned application as its top priority for consideration in this year's Community Legacy program; and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, copies of this Resolution are sent to the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland.


