Cumberland Historic Preservation Commission Meeting Cancelled

Due to the Proclamation of Governor Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr. dated March 5, 2020 proclaiming a state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency related to COVID-19, the Cumberland Historic Preservation Commission's May 13, 2020 meeting has been cancelled. All Certificates of Appropriateness requiring review by the Historic Preservation Commission's review will be deferred to the June 10, 2020 meeting, pending the status of the COVID-19 health emergency. Staff will continue to review applications for a Certificate of Appropriateness for projects involving only "in-kind" replacement during this period.
